PENNSYLVANIA ARMY NATIONAL GUARD MISSILE UNITS
(NIKE-AJAX) OPERATIONAL INTEGRATION INTO
CONUS ARMY AIR DEFENSE

Pursuant to authority contained in First Indorsement Letter, Department of the Army and the Air Force, National Guard Bureau, File NG-AROTA (17 July 1959) dated 21 July 1959, Subject: Operational Integration Into CONUS Army Air Defense, Pennsylvania Army National Guard Missile On-Site Program and First Indorsement Letter, Headquarters Second Region United States Army Air Defense Command, Fort George G. Meade, Maryland, Subject: Assumption of Operational Mission by Pennsylvania Army National Guard Missile Battalions Philadelphia Defense, dated 3 May 1960; the following Units Pennsylvania Army National Guard (NIKE-AJAX) are designated operational and integrated components of the United States Army Air Defense System effective 1100 Hours local time 30 April 1960.
